SPARCbook 3TX is the ideal platform for taking powerful Solaris applications on the road. Weighing around 7lb, it's a fully functional SPARCstation you can take anywhere. The magnesium alloy case is rugged enough to survive traveling, and its notebook size means that you can carry it onto a plane.

Workstation-class performance

Equivalent in performance to a SPARCstation 20, SPARCbook 3TX is powered by a 170MHz TurboSPARC processor, giving the power you need for demanding engineering, analysis or database applications. Upgradable memory configurations up to 128MB mean that your application need never be short of memory. The internal removable hard disk has a capacity of 1.2GB, and the built-in SCSI interface makes it easy to add fast, inexpensive external SCSI storage.

Solaris power wherever you need to go

SPARCbook 3TX makes mobility with power a reality. Rather than waste time reconfiguring your system for different locations, you can keep different configurations on separate removable hard disks, making your configuration and data secure. You don't even have to reboot between Sessions - Tadpole's Save and Resume technology allows you to save your session to disk and get right back to work within a minute of power on. And, with around 1.5 hours from the optional external battery, the SPARCbook 3TX gives you the power to work longer.

Access to Windows applications

The SPARCbook 3TX runs the SPARC-based Solaris operating environment, so it's fully compatible with all of your Sun applications. And, the SPARCbook 3TX eliminates the need to carry another portable PC by providing Pentium-level performance for your Windows applications via SunSoft's WABI.

Ideal for demonstrations

The integrated 16-bit stereo audio interface provides CD-quality sound for impressive presentations and multimedia applications. For bright, clear graphics, the SPARCbook 3TX provides up to an amazing 32-bit graphics within its internal 10.4" active matrix TFT display at 800x600 resolution (16 bit) and up to 1280x1024 resolution on an external color display. With 2MB of video RAM and a Weitek P9100 graphics accelerator, you get quick response and fast screen redraws.

The most extensive connectivity options in a portable computer

Built-in Ethernet makes networking easy. And Tadpole's Notebook Computing Environment provides a suite of communications utilities that make reconfiguring your network connection simple and power management tools that maximize battery life. The SPARCbook 3TX's integral modem with send/receive fax provides a link to your base of operations. The built-in Sun-compatible ISDN port provides access to digital networks at up to 128Kbps, and twin PCMCIA slots allows faster modem or storage cards to be plugged in. To complete the full complement of interfaces, two serial ports, a parallel port, a Sun keyboard/mouse and stereo audio in/out connectors are available at the back of the unit.
